The availability of electricity adds to its development potential. Located in the Haysville School District. Zoned as SF-20 Single Family & Rural Residential, this land presents an opportunity for development, home sites, or agricultural investment.

Location: Located at the northeast corner of Tyler Rd & MacArthur Rd in Wichita, KS.

Tract 1: $20 \pm$ acres to all cultivation with a historical red barn on the northeast corner of Tyler Rd & MacArthur Rd. The 1909 barn is approximately 30×45 feet full of charm with a tin roof. This tract is zoned SF-20 and offers great potential for housing development or single family use.
